The NIV and NASB are continually changing with each new edition. Presently, there are 450+ unique New Age Versions of the Bible.

With the acceptance of divergent and rejected readings has come the rejection of the doctrines of true Bible preservation, infallibility and authority. These doctrines have been relegated to the autographed writings or original languages. Still, all new English Bibles prefer translating from a Classical Greek type and not the original Koine Greek. Scripture teaches these doctrines apply to **the words** and never the languages, nor the original documents. The "scriptures" used in the New Testament were not the infallible originals, but infallible, preserved copies.

Scripture, in churches, schools and homes with erroneous English Bibles and doctrines is constantly being *corrected* with Greek and Hebrew dictionaries, and countless ways to say passages *better*. Here, pastors and teachers are using "the words which man's wisdom teacheth" and not "comparing spiritual things with spiritual" (1 Cor. 2:13). Here, preaching is "having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof" (2 Tim. 3:5). Here, the Bible is corrected by Man instead of the Bible correcting Man. Just the way Satan would have it.



Subtle seducers "speaking perverse things" have been hard at work beguiling and corrupting the minds of Christians (Acts 20:29-31, 2 Cor. 11:3). Christians are now neck deep in heaping to themselves teachers after "their own lusts." More than ever before, by any means, Christians "turn away *their* ears from the truth" (2 Tim 4:3-4).

Deception, by design, is undetectable without discernment. Amid all the success of contemporary Christianity, prevailing errors suppress the truth and spread the "famine... of hearing the words of the LORD" (Amos 8:11).

In the absence of the truth, Christians are busy stimulating their senses; mistaking feelings and experiences for the sanctifying and edifying of their spirits. But what is the critical issue that escalates this flood of "falling away" from the absolute truth and pure faith (2 Thes. 2:3)?

## "Yea, hath God said...?"

Men and women from within and without the flock help **the Devil** infiltrate new versions of **the Bible!** His point of attack (the word of God), his method (subtlety) and his lure (to make one wise) have been his deceptive devices since that day in the Garden of Eden (Gen 3:1-6).


Most are unaware of how this deception has crept into contemporary churches. The history of events are skewed in every compromising evangelical church, college and seminary; where many are "ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth." What is taught is in fact the "[opposition]... to the acknowledging of the truth" (2 Tim. 3:6-7, 2 Tim. 2:25-26).

Yet, "we are not ignorant of [Satan's] devices" (2 Cor. 2:11). New versions of the Bible are translated from a minority (less than 1%) of the Greek New Testament manuscripts in existence today. These minority manuscripts "bare false witness" and "agree not together" in over 3,000 places in the Gospels alone (Mark 14:56).

Changed into Classical or Attic Greek from the original Koine Greek, these minority texts were rejected by Christianity for about 1500 years! One codex (book) was suddenly 'discovered' in the Vatican and was used in an attempt to suppress the Protestant Reformation. Another codex, found in fine condition, (discarded for inferior scribal work and known errors) was pulled out of a monastery's wastebasket in the Sinai Peninsula in 1859.

New Bible versions are not just updated English, but updated English of an inferior minority of rejected, divergent readings, which are not even in the original Koine Greek dialect.

New Bible perversions have designs to "deceive the whole world" by "seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils" with "another Jesus, another spirit, another gospel" (Rev. 12:9, 1 Tim 4:1, 2 Cor. 11:4).



These perversions actually cause "divisions" and "contentions" as it is impossible for users to "all speak the same thing... in the same mind and in the same judgment" (1Cor. 1:10-11).

All Generations: The King James Bible has the pure words of the LORD, preserved by God to this generation for ever (Ps 12:6-7 km) in English. The KJV matches the Bishops', Geneva, Tyndale, Wycliffe, Anglo-Saxon, and the pre-350 A.D. Gothic Bible.

New version readings have been hidden away for many generations, close to no mans heart or mouth (Rom. 10:8). They "add unto these things, ...take away from the words" and have "changed the truth of God into a lie" (Rev. 22:18-19, Rom. 1:25).

All Nations: Only the King James Bible matches "the scriptures... to all nations," which the "Holy Ghost" gave "every nation under heaven" in their "own language" (Rom 16:26, Acts 2:4,5,6, see 1 Cor. 14:21, Is. 28:11). Only the KJV matches the historic Greek, Hebrew, Syriac, Spanish, Italian, French, German, Dutch, Old Latin, Polish, and other language scriptures, written before the KJV.

Spurred on by "the love of money" and "bound" by copyright law, new perversions disagree among themselves in English and by no means match other languages (1 Tim 6:10, 2 Tim 2:9). "God is not the author of confusion" and would have "all things be done decently and in order" (1 Cor. 14:33, 40).
